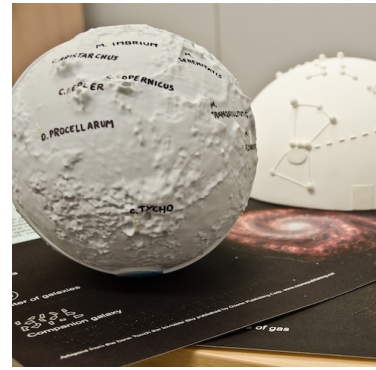


## GIVE THE UNIVERSE TO A BLIND KID!
